

## Cyclone Information for Parents from Hedland Senior High School

### Blue Alert

In a Blue Alert the school will usually remain open.

If a Yellow Alert is predicted and likely to be declared at some time during the school day, the school will not open and children are to remain at home.

If the school is to close, this information will be broadcast via the schools Facebook, text message, Connect and School website and local/ABC radio station.

School closure will be broadcasted between 6.15am-7.45am.

The closure advice will be repeated each morning until the decision to re-open the school is made. School buses may be affected at this stage. Any change to the bus operation will be given on the radio each morning.

PLEASE DO NOT RING THE SCHOOL. All information and updated reports relating to the warnings and school closure **ARE ISSUED ON THE RADIO**. Please keep your self-informed

### Yellow Alert

If a Yellow Alert is declared during a school day, the following will occur:

Information will be broadcast via the schools text message, Connect and School website and local/ABC radio station.

Parents need to collect their children from Roberts Road and sign them out. If students can't be collected by parents they will be supervised until arrangements are made to take them home.

### Red Alert

The school will remain closed during a Red Alert.

## After the Cyclone

The following day, the school is closed. The Department of Finance (Building Maintenance and Works) will do an inspection for assessment and repair of serious damage. Once cleared, the school will be re-opened. Parents will be notified by Facebook, text message, Connect and local/ABC radio station.
