Eligibility: You must be available for 1 hour a week after school to meet as the Student Council and with the Principal in 2021 (the day and time will be negotiated at the beginning of 2021). This will ensure enough time is provided for the Student Council to participate in team building, school activities and preparation for fundraising events throughout the year.

Application: You must be endorsed by two staff members, two students and your parents or guardians must provide a brief statement.
